Distance and Time Chart of Major Buddhist Pilgrimage Site in India



Lord Buddha's Enlightenment Story



Lord Buddha's enlightenment, also known as Bodhi, is considered one of the most significant events in the history of Buddhism. It marks the moment when the Buddha attained complete and perfect understanding of the nature of reality and the path to liberation from suffering. According to tradition. Buddhist the Buddha achieved enlightenment after six years of intense spiritual practice, including meditation and asceticism. One day, while sitting under a Bodhi tree, he entered into deep meditation and experienced a profound realization of the nature of reality. The Buddha saw clearly that all beings are subject to suffering, and that the root cause of suffering is attachment and craving. He also saw that it was possible to overcome this suffering by following the Eightfold Path, which includes ethical conduct, mental discipline. and wisdom. After enlightenment, the Buddha began to teach his insights to others, and his teachings eventually spread throughout India and beyond. He founded the Buddhist tradition, which has since become one of the world's major religions.





The story of the Buddha's enlightenment is an important reminder of the potential for all beings to achieve spiritual awakening, and of the power of compassion, wisdom, and inner peace. It continues to inspire Buddhists and non-Buddhists alike to this day. Read more about how Lord Buddha attained enlightenment and gave the world The Four Noble Truths and Eightfold Path.

Today, the following are recognised as major destinations for Buddhist pilgrims seeking to follow the footsteps of the Buddha.

- Lumbini (Nepal) where the Buddha was born
- Bodhgaya (Bihar, India) where the Buddha gained Enlightenment under the Bodhi Tree
- Sarnath (in Uttar Pradesh, India) where the Buddha gave the First Sermon
- Kushinagar (in Uttar Pradesh, India) where the Buddha entered Parinirvana
- Raigir (in Bihar) site where the Buddha gave many important sermons
- Nalanda (in Bihar) location of famous Buddhist university in medieval times
- Kapilavastu (India/Nepal border) where the Buddha spent His childhood and married life before renouncing to seek the Truth
- Vaishali (in Bihar) where the Buddha gave His last sermon
- Sravasti (in Uttar Pradesh) where the Buddha spent most of His life during rainy seasons at the Jetavan monastery (built by Anathapindika)


BUDDHISM IN INDIA

THE LIFE AND TIMES OF THE ENLIGHTENED ONE

Buddhism, or the spiritual tradition of the awakened one, Buddha, (Buddha-dharma) is regarded as one of the three most widespread major world religions. Buddhism was founded by the historical Buddha Shakyamuni or Gautama, in the 5th or the 6th centuries B.C.E.

The basic teachings of the Buddha can be recapitulated in the Tripitaka - the three collections of: Vinaya-pitaka (the collection of discipline), Sutra-pitaka (collection of discourses), and Abhidharma-pitaka (collection abhidharma or metaphysics). The main subject matter or the purpose of these teaching is, respectively, the development of the three higher of discipline, trainings concentration transcendental knowledge, while their function is to remedy the three poisons of desire, anger and delusion.







Bodhgaya

Gautam Buddha attained his enlightenment in Bodhgaya under the Bodhi Tree. All pilgrims are asked to perform rites for their departed ancestors as it appeases them upon their visit to one of the main attractions of Buddhist tourism in India.

Rajgir

Rajgir is another holy pilgrimage place for Buddhists. Devotees of Lord Mahavira and Gautam Buddha are known to visit Rajgir in huge numbers. In the Rajgir Buddhist sector tour, Travel with RV covers Bimbisara Jail, Gridhakuta Hills and Venuvana Monastery.





Nalanda

Buddhist Pilgrimage Tour in India covers Nalanda which was a significant town where Buddhism was practiced with sincerity. It was an esteemed center for learning and practicing Buddhism for over 800 years starting the 5th Century. Nalanda city sightseeing places are Nalanda Ruins, Nalanda Archaeological Site, Nalanda International University.

Sarnath

Buddha religious tours and travels take you to Sarnath. It is located in Uttar Pradesh near the point where Ganges and Varuna river meet. Buddha gave his first sermon here. Sightseeing places are Dhamek Stupa, Sarnath Museum, Mulagandha Kuti Vihar, Deer Park


Vaishali

Five years after His Enlightenment at Bodhgaya, the Buddha came to Vaishali, famed as one of the first 'republican' states in the world. He was received by the noble Lichchavi community, to whom He preached the Ratna Sutra.

Kushinagar

The last of the four holy Buddhist sites is Kushinagar. Located at Gorakhpur, in the state of Uttar Pradesh, the Buddha was said to have laid between two sala trees at Kushinagar while resting before entering Parinirvana. When the Buddha breathed his last, His last words were "Subject to change are all conditioned things. Strive on with diligence.










Lumbini

The Buddha was born as Prince Sidhhartha, heir to King Suddhodhana and Queen Maya of the Shakya clan. According to Buddhist traditions. more than 2500 years ago, Queen Maya had a dream of a white elephant entering a womb - a sure sign of an auspicious pregnancy. She was soon pregnant and after months, she was due to give birth. As per the customs of that time, she had to return to her matrimonial home to give birth. Along the way, she stopped at Lumbini where she gave birth to the Prince while holding on to a Sal tree branch.





Sravasti

The Buddha stayed in Anandakuti and Gandhakuti, whose ruins still remain, and are sacred to the Buddhist pilgrims. The whole Sangha used to congregate in Sravasti, with the Buddha, during the 'Vassavassa' or 'Rainy retreat' season.

Sankisa

Lord Buddha after delivering sermons to his mother in heaven descended to earth. This direct association of Lord Buddha makes Sankisa or Sankasia a favoured destination for Buddhist pilgrims. Known as Sankasya in Ramayana, this village has received many mentions, including the one from the Chinese traveller, Hiuen Tsang. He named this city as Kapittha in his travelogue and described it as a nice place to visit.

Sanchi

Sanchi Shanti Stupa which is situated in Raisen District that is 46 km North East of Bhopal, The Sanchi Stupa is the most ancient stone structure in Madhya Pradesh as it was commissioned by Ashoka and designed by his wife Devi. The Stupa houses the inscriptions and relics of Maha Moggallana and Sariputra who are the two principal disciples of Buddha. This Shanti Stupa is also the place from where king Mahinda set out to proselytize the kingdom of Lanka.


Ajanta Caves

There are 29 caves built for Buddhist monks. They were constructed for the monks to perform rituals in chaityas and viharas. Buddhist monks utilised simple tools like hammer and chisel to carve out brilliant structures. The walls of these caves adorn beautiful carvings and paintings. The sculptures depict stories of Jataka tales.

Ellora Caves

There are in all 34 caves at Ellora. These caves depict the faith in three prominent religions in India viz Hinduism, Buddhism and Jainism. These caves are brilliantly carved on the sides of a hill at a distance of 30 kms from Aurangabad. The 12 caves devoted to Buddhism are situated in South, 17 devoted to Hinduism are situated in centre and remaining 5 caves devoted to Jainism in the North.





Dharamshala

Dharamshala is found in state of Himachal Pradesh in Kangra District and is a hill station. This is headquarter for His Holiness the Dalai Lama in 1960. So far, it has gained its international reputation by being referred to as "The Little Lhasa in India". Perched almost 1,500 meters above the sea level, it is a major Buddhist pilgrimage housing several monasteries and important Buddhist temples. The Dalai Lama resides in the Tsuglagkhang Complex, while the Namgyal Monastery is an important Buddhist temple in India.



Lalitagiri

Located 90km from Bhubaneswar in the state of Orisa, Lalitigiri is geographically spread between 20degrees and 86degrees latitude. There are numerous sites to visit in Lalitagiri. These include the ruins of the Buddhist monastery. Its famous 1st century Buddhist complex is



pulling in visitors from all corners of the world. Found in Odisha, the complex comprises major stupas as well as monasteries. It is almost similar to Ratnagiri and Udayagiri which are part of Puspagiri University.



Udaigiri & Khandagiri

Udayagiri, historically known as Madhavapura Mahavihara, is a Buddhist Complex in Odisha and is composed of monasteries or Viharas and major stupas. It is similar to Ratnagiri, and together with Lalitagiri, form part of Puspagiri University. Perhaps what makes the place well known is its numerous caves with their unique inscriptions.



Om Ami Dewa Hrih

Nagarjunakonda

An ancient Buddhist site which is an island located near Nagarjuna Sagar in district. On reaching Nagarjunakonda Boat club, a 45 minutes ferry ride takes you to Nagarjunakonda Island. It is close to Hyderabad 03 Hrs. drive 150 Km. The place is significant for the ruins of historic Buddhist structures which date from the first to the third centuries CE.




